Oktoberfest in Munich, Germany is the world's largest celebration of Bavarian culture. This region in southeast Germany is famous for beers, brats, and its use of bustiers. Millions of visitors travel thousands of miles to Munich each year to revel in the 2-week long festival.

The original event honored the marriage of Kronprinz Ludwig (later King Ludwig I of Bavaria) and Princess Therese of of Saxe-Hildburghausen on October 12, 1810. Festivities, including horse races, took place on October 17 on the grounds of Theresienwiese. Though there weren't any beer tents or fairground rides at the time, it marked the birth of Oktoberfest.
